Simultaneous Submissions: Yes. Please notify if accepted elsewhere.

Unpublished Submissions: Yes

Manuscript Returned: No

Payment: One copy, additional copies available to contributors at cost plus shipping fee

What to Submit: MS, SASE #10 envelope or email address for notification

Length Limit: **Fiction and Non-fiction**... Each work no more than 6,000 words – 12,000 words total, double spaced

**Poetry**...No more than five poems, single spaced

**Art Work**...Black and white photos and drawings accepted for book  
Full color original artwork accepted for cover
